Issue/Scenario: You have just made a valid arrest for Shoplifting. You are driving a relief car with no prisoner cage. Where do you place the prisoner in the car for proper and safe transport.

Discussion: The prisoner should be placed in the rear passenger seat and seat belted in place with their hands properly handcuffed behind their back.

If two prisoners are arrested, a second officer should ride with you. The second officer should ride in the rear seat on the driver's side and the second prisoner in the front passenger seat. This method would allow the second officer to intervene should either prisoner try to assault the vehicle driver.

A better solution would be to request assistance with a properly equipped transport vehicle.
