Issue/Scenario: You have just made an arrest of a male in his home for an offense of Aggravated Assault – Domestic Violence. The suspect is wheelchair bound and unable to walk on his own.

How do you transport him to the holding facility.?

Discussion: Depending on the individuals size and willingness to assist officers in his transport, the individual may be transported in the police vehicle with the wheelchair carried in the truck or another vehicle. The individual will need the use of his hands to assist him into the vehicle and may be handcuffed in front after being placed in the vehicle, with the cuffs secured under the prisoners belt.

If the prisoner is too large or uncooperative, a supervisor should be called to the scene. The Fire Department can be requested to assist with transport in an ambulance if needed.

The on-duty supervisor will make contact with the Fire Department.
